The Egyptian Journal of Sheep and Goat Sciences is the official publication of The Egyptian Association for Sheep and Goats. It is published twice every year.

Membership fee in the Egyptian Association for Sheep & Goats is L.E. 50.00 annually for Egyptians. and US Dollar 50.00 for non Egyptians and Egyptians living abroad. Membership fee cover the cost of the Journal and its postage. Dues are payable in advance, each year, to the Association account. Membership for Egyptians not interest in the Scientific Journal asked to pay L.E. 24.00 annually only.

The Journal welcomes original and new findings on sheep & goats.

### **Publishing language**

English is the main language for publishing. However, publishing in Arabic or French with exclusive English summary is acceptable. Arabic scientists are kindly asked to provide Arabic summary with their articles.

### **Publishing fees and instructions:**

- 65.00 US Dollar is charged for every published article of maximum 10 pages of the Journal format size, including postal cost.
- Manuscripts should not exceed 10 pages of the journal format, including tables, figures and references, otherwise extra payment of 4.00 US Dollar per page will be added. However,

Egyptian articles will be charged L.E. 150.00 and L.E. 12.00 for every extra page.

- Optional payment of 18 US Dollar to receive 10 copies of article reprints. For Egyptians the 10 reprints cost L.E. 50.00. Additional payment will be asked for extra page at rate of US \$ 1.00 or L.E. 3.00, per page.
- Please, payment for reviewing (US \$ 25.00 or L.E. 50.00) would be delivered in advance before sending article to reviewers.
- All procedures for publishing will be held until payment of fees or at least receiving an image copy of the money transfer document.
- Black & white photos will be published free of charge, however authors will pay the cost of any color photos.
- For non-Egyptian publications, only emailed articles are accepted. The Association will handle printing and distribution to the reviewers.
- For Egyptians, three printed copies of the manuscript, double space with lines numbered, full A4 page size, needed for reviewing. The first page shows only the title and keywords. A covering page includes the title, authors' names and addresses needed to attach.
- Reviewers comment will be emailed to authors to prepare a final draft.
- The final drafts should be sent back in electronic format (email or CD).

### **Guidance Information**

- **Form and style of manuscripts:** All manuscripts should be written according to the style of the Journal of Sheep and Goats Production. Refer to web site: [www.easg.jeeran.com](http://www.easg.jeeran.com) for example and format.
- Page format; paper size B5, with 2.5 cm margins for all directions (top, bottom, right & left) and left gutter of 1.0 cm. layout, different header and footer. Font 11: Times New Roman.
- Software used for writing would be Microsoft Word.
- Tables, figures and photos should be placed within the text.
- Table's format is essential to construct, as each mean value or columns' heading typed in a separate cell, i.e., do not put all means in a column in one cell. Please consider the size of the pages while preparing tables and graphs & image.
- Sub-titles are written in italics (Times New Roman, Font 12) (lined in the manuscript) with only the first letter of the first word in capital.
- Following the title, author(s) name(s) (with initials preceding) and address(es), articles are often divided into the following sections: **SUMMARY** (not more than 250 words), **INTRODUCTION**, **MATERIALS** and **METHODS**, **RESULTS** and **DISCUSSION**, **CONCLUSIONS**, **ACKNOWLEDGMENT(S)** and **REFERENCES**.
- Capitalize the letters of the major work in both the article's title and the sections titles, e.g. **MATERIAL AND METHODS** (Times New Roman, Font 12 Bold). Text written font 11 regular.
- Within the text keep the following formats:

- Abbreviations of the Journal of Animal Science (D.S.A) are adopted for our Journal. Any other abbreviations must be defined. Notice that a period (dot) (.) is put after the abbreviation.
- Enumerations Zero to ten should be spelled out, e.g. Zero, one, two, ... etc. Values greater than ten or that followed by abbreviated units are written in Arabic numerals. (e.g. II animals, 49 wk).
- Tables must be legible self explained and fitting the page size. Avoid, as possible, tables which can be included only in horizontal direction or in more than on page. Use footnote under tables to explain its contents when needed. The table heading is written as: Table 2. Means of ..... Capitalize the first letter of the first word in each column heading. Footnotes are referred to by numbers 1, 2,
- Tables fonts; Title & headings font 11 bold, numbers font 11 regular.
- Tables, Figures and Plates are referred to in the text by capital first letter T, F and P.
- Do not repeat information in tables and graphs. Select one tool to present results effectively.
- Referring to authors would show in name for single or double followed by Year, e.g. **Garrette (1990)**, **Ahmed and Cline (1989)**. In case of three or more authors the name of the first author only is mentioned followed by *et al.* **(1989)**.(Authors & years within text written bold)
- In the references section, each reference is shown in the following succession; name of author(s), Year, title and editing authority, plus publishing Co. in case of books and symposia. In case of periodicals the volume No. is followed by the number of the first page of the article, if the reference is a book or symposium the pages of the article referred to are shown as pp. 42- 46, or the chapter No. stated in italic (lined in the manuscript) the periodical name (e.g. J. Anim. Sci.), in case of books the first letter of each main word of the title is capital.
- In the references; names and year font 11 bold, other font 11 regular.

- Key words position after the English summary, not more than five key words, font 11 italic.

**Key words:** *sheep, digestibility, .... etc.*

- Arabic summary: Font type Simplified Arabic; Title, authors' names font 11 bold; affiliations, text font 11 regular.
- In the Text, References of one or two Authors should be by their Surnames and year. References of more than two names are shown as the Surname of the first Author and *et al.* In the List of References, References should have an alphabetical order giving: Surname(s) and abbreviated first name(s) of the Author(s), year, title of the paper, name of the Journal (i.e. place of publication) complete (not abbreviated), number of the volume, numbers of the first and last pages. For books, title and place of publication should be mentioned.
- Following the title, author(s) name(s) (with initials preceding) and address(es), articles are often divided into the following sections: Summary (not more than 250 words), Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, Acknowledgment(s) and References and all should be written in Font 14 Bold and begin with a capital letter. Sub-titles are written in italics.
- Plates should be high gloss-prints of good contrast.
- Latin names in the Text and titles of books and Journals in the List of References should be written in *Italics*.
- Weights and measures must be expressed in the metric system and temperatures in centigrade.
- Enumerations zero to ten are written in letters, e.g. zero, one, two, ... etc. Values greater than ten or that followed by abbreviated units are written in Arabic numerals, e.g. 49 wk..
- All pages including those of tables, plates and figures must be numbered.
